



An LMIA is an employer-driven application, requesting permission from the Canadian government to hire a foreign worker on the grounds that the employer is not able to find a suitable Canadian Citizen or Permanent Resident (PR) to fill that position.

The Labour Market Impact Assessment (LMIA)



The Foreign National may be eligible to apply for Permanent Residence through:

EXPRESS ENTRY
or
PROVINCIAL NOMINATION PROGRAMS

WE RECEIVED A POSITIVE LMIA NOW WHAT?

1. Apply for and receive work visa
2. Candidate arrives to Canada
3. Issued a 1 or 2 year EXTENDABLE work permit

THE APPLICATION PROCESS

1. Advertise the position for 30 days
2. Submit LMIA application package
3. Telephone interview with Employment and Social Development Canada (ESDC)
4. LMIA Confirmation
5. Work Permit Application
